ABOUT SUMMER COOL:

Now open to middle and high school aged kids, **Kids Summer Art Camp** has become **Summer Cool: Student Theatre & Arts!** Students will learn visual and theatre arts with two instructors, Barbara Gregson and Brandon Law, creating portraits of themselves and one another and practicing the Renaissance tradition of mask making. Participants will then practice the arts of improvisation, mime and storytelling, putting their new skills to work for a real performance on the Martin W. Kappel Stage! "*Me, Myself & I*" will be offered in three one-week sessions each culminating in a Friday performance for family and friends. COVID vaccination is required for all students and staff.

The three one-week sessions are as follows:
